Our 9th Annual Strut for the Mutts to be Held September 14th, 2013

Join us Saturday, September 14, at Higginbotham Park for the 9th Annual Strut for the Mutts! The Strut for the Mutts is a fundraiser held each year by the Haven Animal Shelter, and all proceeds from the event go directly to caring for the animals at the shelter, which currently include 1 horse, over 60 dogs, and about 60 cats.

The Strut for the Mutts has always been a 1-mile walk around Higginbotham Park. Since we are always looking for ways to make the Strut bigger and better, this year we are adding a 5K fun run/walk! The Haven brings 15-20 adoptable Haven dogs for the event, and people can sign up to walk them (or this year run with them) during the event. If you are interested in walking a Haven dog, you do have to preregister. The Haven dogs typically are claimed as walking buddies very quickly!

The 5K will begin at 8:00 am and the 1-mile walk will begin at 10:00 am. That means that you can actually participate in both if you'd like! To participate in the 5K, you must preregister. This is simply so that we know exactly how many people will be running at one time (for City of Lubbock purposes) around the park. You can pre-register for the 1-mile walk or you can do a walk-up registration the morning

of the walk beginning at 9:00 am. Every pre-registered participant is guaranteed a t-shirt, and every dog is guaranteed a bandana!

To register for the Strut, you have a number of options. You can go to the Haven's website, www.havenacs.org and click on the registration form on the front page (you can even pay via Paypal securely on our site!), or you can go to any area United Supermarkets, J&B Coffee, veterinarian clinics, or pet groomers to pick up a registration form. We will accept pre-registrations right up until Friday evening, September 13, but we do ask that if you register after September 1 that you do it by emailing your form to havenacs@gmail.com and paying via Paypal or bring money with you to the Strut.

Packet and t-shirt pickup for the Strut 5K and 1 mile walk will be held Friday, September 13 from 11-7 at the Schlotzsky's located at 3715 19th Street in Lubbock. If you can't make it to pick up your packet and shirt, we ask that you arrive at Higginbotham Park by 7:15 am Saturday for the run and by 9:00 am for the walk so that we can get it to you then.

And don't forget...we always have a large raffle drawing at the conclusion of the 1-mile walk! This year, we are really focusing on raffle items that would fit a wide range of people...not just pet owners. Every registered participant receives a raffle ticket. If you would like more raffle tickets, all you need to do is bring donations for the Haven. If you are curious what we can use for donations, feel free to visit our website to get the list of current needs (our list includes everything from special dog and cat food to cleaning supplies and gift cards to home improvement stores).

Haven Hope for Animals



The Haven Hope for Animals Fund began accepting referrals on Valentine's Day, February 14, 2013. This is a spay/ neuter program funded by a personal donation of \$100,000.00 from Dr. Brenda Wilbanks, Founder and Executive Director of the Haven Animal Care Shelter, Inc. Referrals are being accepted for this pilot program from veterinarians, Animal Services, other animal organizations, and pet owners. An application is available for Haven Hope on the Haven website.

The purpose of this pilot program is to help in assessing what type of spay/neuter program would be feasible within the Lubbock area, and at the same time beginning to make a difference in the overpopulation crisis in our area. A voucher system will be utilized and requests will be evaluated on a case by case basis by Dr. Brenda Wilbanks and Haven staff. Emergency vet care for those who need financial help has always been a part of the Haven's contribution and will continue on a limited basis through the Haven Hope program.

Darby has completed numerous building projects, including the Retired Canines Bed and Breakfast. Alexis organizes the Strut for the Mutts each year, and Dalette does everything!

She fills a number of roles, including drill sergeant, dog trainer, organizer of adoption events, and provider of moral support!

All of these wonderful people have full time jobs of their own and still find time to help care for our residents at the Haven.

In addition to these volunteers, you may find over 50 people on some Saturdays at the Haven, all looking for ways to help. These include families who are making their volunteer work a family activity, and college and church groups.

There is a place for everyone at the Haven. Come and join us in out efforts to save the lives of helpless animals!
